GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS.

1. All regular freight trains shown herein will be run as arranged, performing the work outlined, which is shown only in a general way.

Special instructions changing work of any train may be issued

from day to day as occasion requires.

The service as shown herein must not be permanently curtailed, added to or changed without authority from Superintendent of Transportation.

- 2. All regular freight trains handling mixed classes of freight, such as way-freights, drop and pick-up trains, travelling switchers, etc., will be given an approximate schedule.
 - 3. Extras will be run as the business demands.
- 4. Nothing contained herein confers track, running or timetable rights to any train, or in any way affects crew runs, which are of course advertised by Division people.
- 5. Train dispatchers must see that the trains specified herein are run as set forth, and handle the class of freight for which they are arranged. They must see that the symbol trains have preference over all extra or irregular freight trains, and that the arranged extra trains follow as near as possible the times as arranged herein. They will keep connecting divisions, junction points and yards fully informed as to the movement of the trains and the number of cars they are to drop or pick up, that they may be prepared to handle the train without delay.
- 6. Freight agents must fully acquaint themselves with the time these arranged trains are due at their station as well as the class of business they are to handle and have freight ready to avoid delay, and will keep the train dispatcher advised as to the number of cars to be forwarded or the number of cars left over by these trains.

to be forwarded or the number of cars left over by these trains.

They must see that train car lists, Forms CT 96 and CT 108, show correct symbols of all symbol trains shown in this book or supplements thereto, and symbols entered in car record books instead

of train or engine number.

In giving records in answer to tracers, state train symbols rather than number of train or engine.

- 7. Yardmasters will familiarize themselves with the character of these trains and see that they handle the business for which they are intended, and where trains terminate they must see that the cars going beyond make proper connection. They will see that yard conductors are supplied with a copy of this arranged service, and that they fully understand the train arrangement, both as to the nature of the work and schedule. They must show train symbols on all X-7 reports and will notify freight conductors of the proper symbol for the train they are to run.
- 8. Freight conductors will be furnished with a copy of this arranged service and must thoroughly inform themselves as to the requirements of same; they must ascertain from the yardmasters the symbol of the train they are to run before leaving initial point and be sure to show symbol on their wheel report, Form 1435. They must notify enginemen before starting as to the symbol under which the train is run.
- 9. The trains herein are arranged to care for a normal freight business and when cars offering are in excess of the limit of the trains, sections or extras will be run if the overflow justifies, and when sections are run they must be given the same movement as the regular arranged trains.
- 10. The time as shown for this arranged service is approximate and may be changed slightly to meet various conditions, including necessary rest for crews. Agents and yardmasters should keep themselves fully informed as to the movement of the service and have their cars or freight ready in case they should reach their station or yard slightly in advance of the arranged time.

EXPLANATION OF TRAIN SYMBOLS.

Trains running under symbol designation will be known as "symbol trains." The symbol is a letter-and-number combination indicating where the train is from and its destination, and is used for the purpose of identity.

The first letter of the symbol signifies the initial or starting point of train and the second letter indicates the final destination of train, and the numbers are used to distinguish one symbol from another.

In using the symbol it must be understood by all interested that the letters alone will not be sufficient, but that the number following the symbol must in every instance be used with the letter to avoid confusion.

The odd numbers following the symbol letters indicate outward trains and even numbers indicate inward trains; viz., B-M 1 is an outward train running from Boston to Mechanicville, and P-B 2 is an inward train, Rigby to Boston.
